

Noorla Yo-Long Student Safety Management Policy

Programs and activities are only available with prior approval and design before arrival at Noorla Yo-Long.

Noorla Yo-Long provides specialist equipment for educational learning programs only. Programs include low ropes course, high rope challenge course, abseiling and ground level initiative activities.

Noorla Yo-Long will provide trained staff to facilitate the running of all its activities. When Noorla Yo-Long staff, including sub-contracted activity providers, demonstrate, lead, instruct or facilitate an activity they will take responsibility for the technical skills and related safety management of students and participants.

Groups Leaders, supervisors and teaching staff are responsible for continued supervision and behaviour at an activity, to and from an activity and for students/participants awaiting their turn.

Noorla Yo-Long staff and sub-contracted activity providers will assume first-aid responsibility while the students/participants are undertaking specialist activities under their control.

Student management and supervision is the responsibility of the group leader, supervisor or teaching staff member at program breaks, lunch periods and program completion.

Noorla Yo-Long staff and sub-contracted activity providers will not be responsible for students/participants during those identified periods

School teachers and group supervisor's are responsible for student behaviour at all times.

Schools and Groups camping overnight at Noorla Yo-Long shall be in the charge of a responsible person at all times. The responsible person will identify themselves to the Noorla Yo-Long camp manager or his assistant upon arrival.

During out of hours, no person's are permitted to use or be on any specialist equipment or activity structure.
